Important Facts

Rotations include:

- 2 week rural EM experience in Artesia, NM during PGY-2 & 3

Pediatric experience:

- Longitudinal experiences and dedicated one month pediatrics rotations during both PGY-2 & 3

Electives:

- EMS in El Paso
- Hyperbaric and marine envenomations in Hawaii
- Rural EM in Alaska
- Wilderness medicine in Taos, NM

Ultrasound experience:

- PGY-1: one month dedicated rotation with minimum of 100 scans
- PGY-2: one month dedicated rotation with minimum 200 scans

Fellowship programs:

- Tactical Medicine Fellowship: training focuses on prehospital emergency care during high risk law enforcement operations, such as SWAT. In addition to weapons training, fellowship includes Peace Officer Training allowing fellows to participate in law enforcement operations as certified peace officer
